



Spread across 20.2 hectares, this sprawling park is Asia's largest with a collection of over 5000 birds from 400 species

The famous **Waterfall Aviary,** one of the world's largest walk-in aviaries, home to more than 600 birds and a 30 m high waterfall

Home to World's largest walk-in lory flight aviary at over 9 stories high

Impressive Penguin Coast where species such as Gentoo, King, and Chinstrap are found

Flamingo Lake comprising hundreds of these strutting birds and **Pelican Cove**, with the world's most complete collection of Pelicans





Visa Filing and Consultancy: The VISA Filing will be taken care of by the organisers while the students have to be ready with just the valid passports.


Date of Departure – The program is scheduled in Dec, 2019.




