Scrutiny of Election Form (Nomination Form) Submitted by Founder Donors 2(b)(i) category for election to the Board of Governors of Daly College Indore

Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria has submitted two forms vide serial No. 1 and 12.

Thakur Narendra Singh Bidwal has also submitted two forms vide serial No. 10 and 11.

Maharaja Vikram Sinh Puar has submitted two forms vide serial No. 14 and 16.

His Highness Raja Priyavrat Singh Khichi has submitted three forms vide serial No. 21, 23 and 25.

Now we will proceed with the scrutiny of forms of founder donors category. In this context, it is required that the guidelines framed by the undersigned Election Officer were duly uploaded on website of the Daly College Society on 27.4.2026, which reads as under:-

- (i) Each candidate can take two Nomination forms either in person or by sending his authorised agent with a copy of original Authorisation.

- (ii) Nomination Forms are not Transferrable and candidates in whose name nomination form is issued has to fill the form and return duly filled form to Secretary of society.
- (iii) Each Candidate will be required to present the nomination form to secretary of society duly filled in person with a copy of Age Proof.


So far as the Election /Nomination Form No. 1 and 12 of Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria are concerned they are in violation of said guidelines since as per guideline No. 1, the nomination forms have to be taken either in person or by sending authorized agent with copy of original authorization whereas in the present case, Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria has not taken nomination form in person as the list of forms received of the society demonstrates that Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria has taken form under the signature of Mr. Jai Jhabua who has also not produced any authorization of Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria thus, the guideline No. 1 have been violated in two ways one taking nomination form neither in person nor by the authorized agent.

That apart the nomination forms were non transferable and while taking nomination form Mr. Jai Jhabua has mentioned that nomination No. 1 and 12 are being taken for his father Mr. Narendra Singh Jhabua whose authorization was sent by e-mail on 28.4.2026. If the register in which form issuance is seen before form No. 12, he has categorically mentioned (Narendra Ji) and before form No. 4 he has not mentioned anything but he has been authorized only by Narendra Singh Jhabua. It is brought to my notice that Mr. Jai Singh Jhabua has submitted two authorizations on mail one of Mr. Narendra Singh Jhabua and other of Thakur Narendra Singh Bidwal and for Thakur Narendra Singh Bidwal he has taken form No. 10 and 11 which have been submitted by Thakur Narendra Singh Bidwal.



Thus so far as Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria are concerned, he has submitted election / nomination form on the forms which were issued for Maharaja Narendra Singh Jhabua hence the guidelines No. 2 is also violated and nomination form have been transferred. Further as per guideline No. 3, the election / nomination form were to be submitted to the Secretary of the society in person and the register maintained for submission / Receipt of forms also establishes that Mr. Jai Singh Jhabua has submitted forms for Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria, thus both the elections/nomination forms submitted by Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria are rejected being in violation to the guidelines prescribed. Further, the name of Mr. Thakur Sahib Anirudh Pratap Singh Ji Dotria as shown in Aadhar Card and PAN card bears the spelling Anirudh whereas one of the nomination form at serial No. 1 bears spelling Anurudh, thus, on this additional count also the election/nomination form deserves to be rejected.

As regard election form bearing serial No. 10 and 11 submitted by Thakur Narendra Singh Ji Bidwal it also suffers from the same infirmity since his forms were also taken by Mr. Jai Singh Jhabua as is clear from form issuance register. Thus, Thakur Narendra Singh Ji Bidwal have also violated guideline No. 1 by not submitting the original authorization as the authorization was submitted by Thakur Narendra Singh Ji Bidwal on e-mail. Even otherwise, the forms have not been submitted in person and have been submitted by Mr. Jai Singh Jhabua. Consequently, his Election /nomination form for serial No. 10 and 11 are also rejected. Further, if one looks at Aadhar Card submitted by him his name is mentioned as Narendra Singh and not Narendra Singh Bidwal, as such it is not clear as to whether Narendra Singh Ji who has submitted the Aadhar Card and Thakur Narendra Singh Ji Bidwal are one or the same person. It is further pertinent to mention here that even signature of Mr.

Narendra Singh Bidwal are not there on documents submitted by him as such this office is not in possession of any document to verify his signature. As such, in view of aforesaid discrepancies his both forms bearing serial No. 10 and 11 are also rejected.

Maharaja Vikram Sinh Puar of Dewas has submitted two elections/nomination forms bearing serial No. 14 and 16 and he has taken the nomination forms himself as is clear from the form issuing register. Not merely this he has appeared in person to submit the form and have signed form received register. Further, along with the election/nomination form he has also submitted his Aadhar Card and Passport which also bears his name as Vikram Sinh Puar, consequently, both his forms No. 14 and 16 are accepted.

His Highness Raja Priyavrat Singh Khichi has submitted form No. 21, 23 and 25 which he has himself taken as is evident from his signatures on form issuance register. Further, he has also submitted the form himself which is also evident from his signature on form received register. Along with said forms he has submitted his Aadhar Card wherein his name has been mentioned as Priyavrat Singh and same name with same spelling has been mentioned in his form but as per the election guidelines he was to take two nomination forms but he has taken 3 nomination forms so a case is made out to reject one of his election/nomination form but in any case if two forms are accepted he would be contesting the election as such his forms no. 21 and 25 are accepted.




**Scrutiny of Election Form (Nomination Form) Submitted by New Donors
2(b)(ii) category for election to the Board of Governors of Daly College

In this category, various persons have submitted the forms.

Mr. Rajesh Agrawal was issued form No. 2 and 5. I have perused the form issuance register as well as form received register and he has himself taken the forms and himself deposited the forms also. Further, he has submitted his Aadhar Card as well as driving license and in both his name has been mentioned as Rajesh Agrawal and therefore both his forms vide serial No. 2 and 5 are accepted.

Mr. Sandeep Parekh has submitted form No. 3 and 6. In the form issuance register as well as in form received register it is seen that he has himself taken the form and submitted the forms in person. Further, he has submitted the Aadhar Card as well as driving license where his name has mentioned as Sandeep Parekh but spelling of Parekh in his driving license is Parikh whereas in form he has written as Parekh. However, this being a minor discrepancy – I have compared the name of his father which is also mentioned as Chotelal in his Aadhar Card as well as driving license. Consequently, ignoring such minor defect, I accept both his nomination forms at serial No. 3 and 6.

Mr. Jayesh Patel has been issued form No. 4 and 7. I have seen the form issuance register as well as form received register and am convinced that Mr. Jayesh Patel has himself taken and submitted the form. Further, he has submitted his Aadhar card and driving license wherein his name is also mentioned as Jayesh Patel, but there is over writing in the name of proposal in form No. 4 which is mentioned as Jay Patel


by cutting the words Jayesh Patel. Similarly, name of father has also been re-written. Accordingly, I accept his form No. 7 and declare that he can contest the election for 2(b)(ii) category but because of overwriting I reject his nomination form with serial No. 4.

Mr. Harpal Singh Bhatia has also submitted election/nomination forms bearing serial No. 17 and 18 and I have seen form issuance register as well form received register and am convinced that he has himself taken and submitted the said forms. Further, he has filed his Aadhar Card as well as passport wherein his name is also mentioned as Harpal Singh Bhatia and fathers name as Gurdeep Singh Bhatia. Consequently, I accept both his election/nomination form bearing serial No. 17 and 18.

Mr. Gurmeet Singh Bhatia has submitted form No. 19 and 20 but he has withdrawn his nomination form as such there is no need to make any scrutiny to his nomination form and accordingly, his voter / nomination form bearing serial No. 19 and 20 are dismissed as withdrawn.

Mr. Neeraj Desai have been issued form No. 24. I have seen the form issuance register as well form received register wherein he has personally taken and submitted the forms. Along with the form he has submitted his Aadhar Card, wherein his name is mentioned as Neeraj Desai son of Vinod Desai, consequently, I accept his form.

The last form i.e. serial No.26 is submitted by **Mr. Manvir Singh Bias** who has not personally taken the form since the form issuance register does not bear his signature but he has personally submitted the form as is evident from his signature on form received register. I have considered the fact that though form issuance register does

not bear his signature and therefore, the presumption can be drawn that he has not submitted the form himself or in person but when I asked the officer of Daly College Society they have verified the said fact from CCTV footage as well as from the video recording done by them, it is clear that Manveer Singh Bias has taken the form himself. Along with form he has submitted his driving license and Aadhar Card wherein his name is mentioned as Manvir Singh Bias. Consequently, his election/nomination form is also accepted.

Considering the fact that the date of hearing as regards scrutiny of Nomination forms is fixed on 03/05/2026, the secretary is directed to upload this order on the website today and thereafter list of successful candidates be uploaded on 03/05/2026 after hearing on objections, if any.


